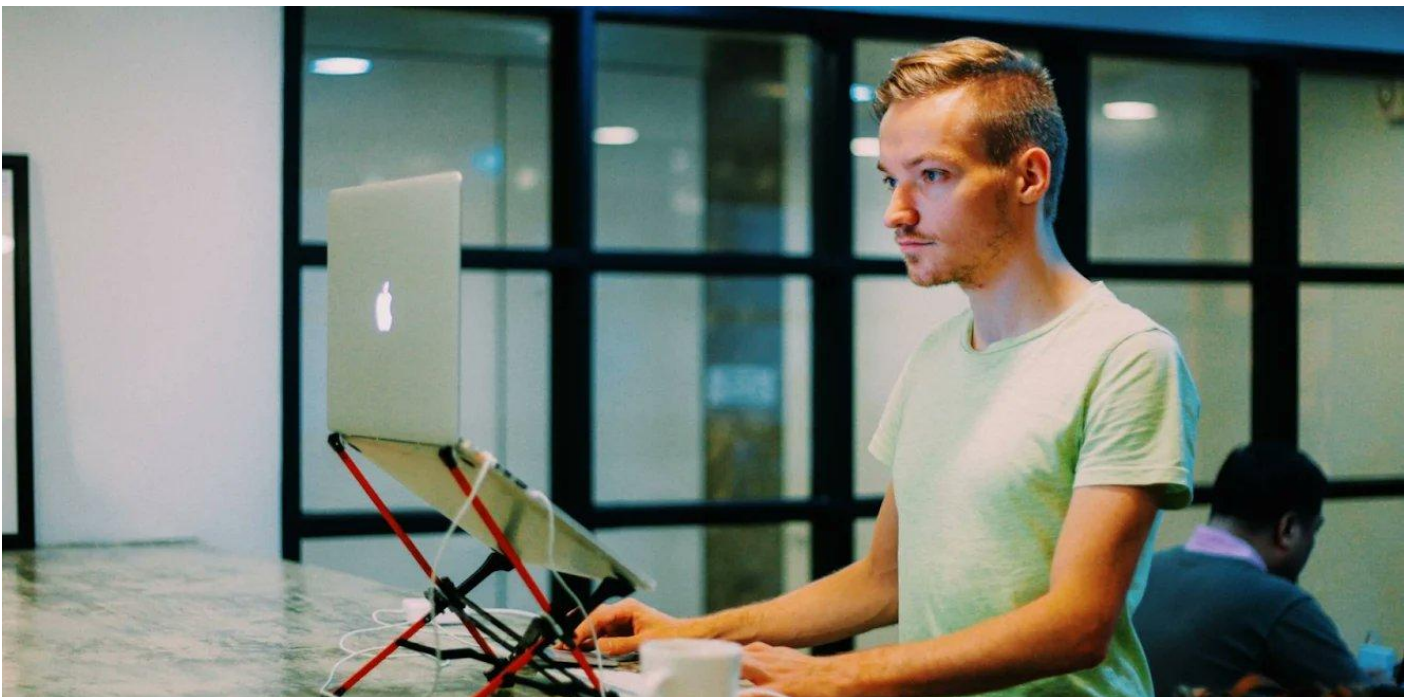

Pieter Levels

Overview

Pieter Levels (the surname is not his real one) (born July 11, 1987) is a Dutch entrepreneur, indie maker, and digital nomad. He is known for creating successful bootstrapped startups and promoting the remote work lifestyle. Pieter is most famous for founding Nomad List, RemoteOK, PhotoAI and dozen of other profitable online projects without external funding.

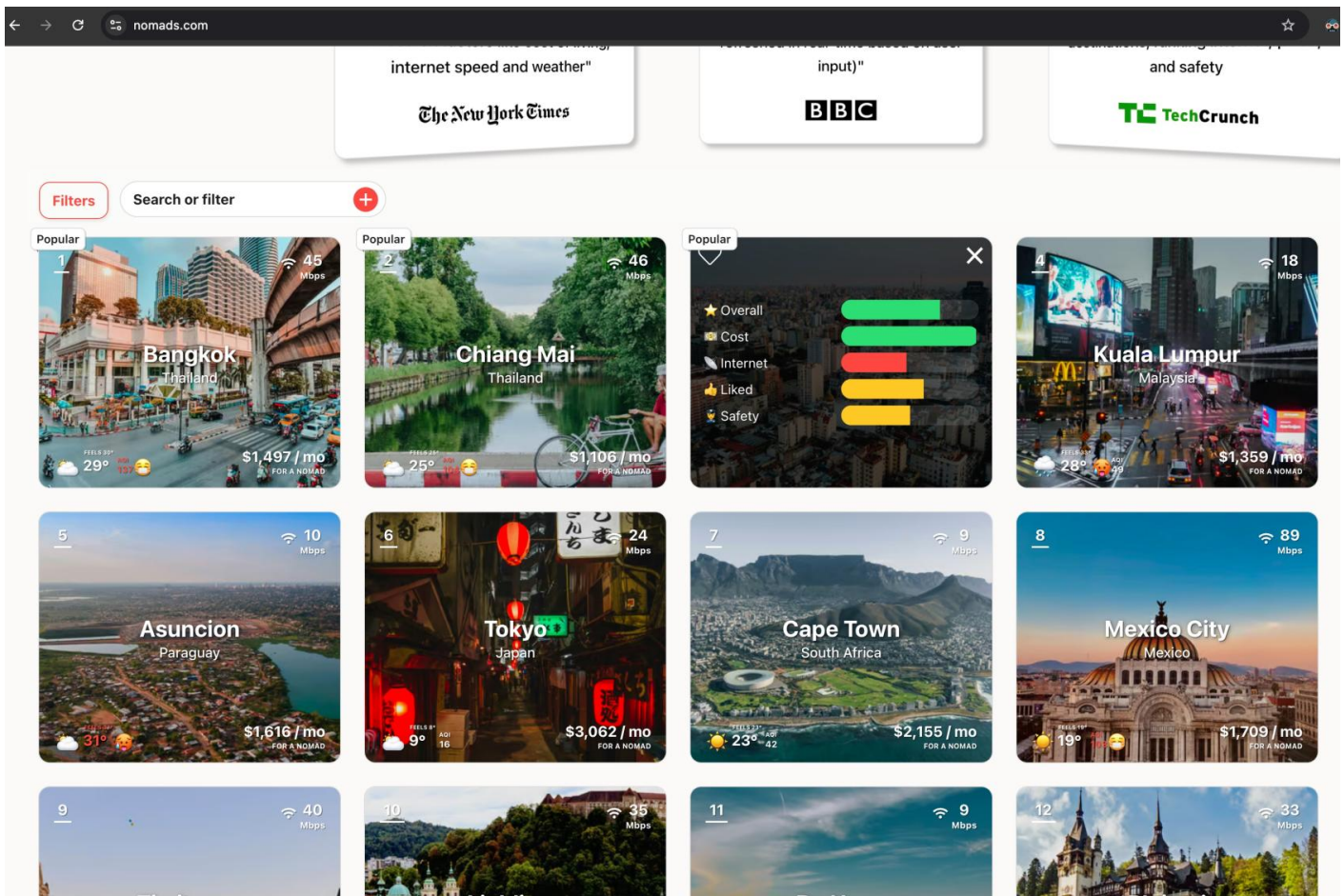


Early Life and Education

Born and raised in Amsterdam, Netherlands, Levels studied music production at the Conservatorium van Amsterdam. Before becoming an entrepreneur, he was a techno music producer and DJ, performing under various aliases.

Notable Projects

Nomad List (2014-present)



[Nomad List](#) is perhaps Levels' most influential creation. The platform helps digital nomads find the best places to live and work remotely by providing detailed city rankings based on various factors including cost of living, Internet speed, weather, safety etc.

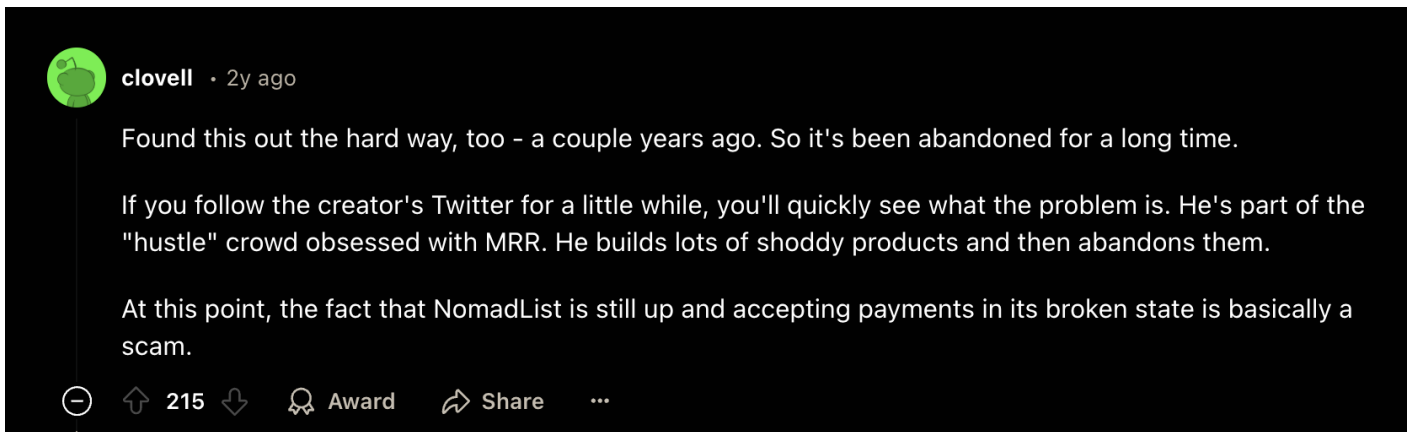
Numbers

The site has become the go-to resource for the digital nomad community, with over 100,000 members. As of 2024, Nomad List has:

- Generated over \$1.5 million in annual recurring revenue
- Collected data on 2,500+ cities worldwide
- Built a community of 100,000+ registered digital nomads
- Processed millions of data points about cities
- Created a social network specifically for digital nomads
- Implemented real-time cost of living updates
- Developed sophisticated climate and air quality tracking

RemoteOK (2015-present)

[RemoteOK](#) is one of the largest job boards globally, connecting remote workers with companies offering remote positions. The platform generates \$26K/m through job postings and has helped thousands of people find remote work opportunities. Key achievements include:

- Over 3 million monthly visitors
- 100,000+ remote jobs posted
- \$2M+ annual revenue
- Companies like Microsoft, Amazon, and Google regularly posting positions

RemoteOK has pioneered the trend of niche job boards. Also, the platform experienced [growth](#) during the COVID-19 pandemic, as the global workforce shifted to remote work, with a 300% increase in traffic and a 150% surge in job postings between 2020 and 2021. This growth was fueled by the rising demand for remote opportunities, as companies adapted to hybrid and fully remote models.
